You will be aware that data protection legislation changed from 25 May 2018 as a result of the General Data Protection Regulation ((EU) 2016/679) and the Data Protection Act 2018. Due to this we need to update the terminology our data sharing agreements.

Section 8.1 of the data sharing agreement you have signed with both Citizens Advice and Citizens Advice Scotland provides;

'Citizens Advice reserves the right to review this Agreement from time to time and will provide to the Authority reasonable notice of and/or consultation on any such variation.'

In light of the changes to data protection legislation, rather than ask you to sign a new data sharing agreement we shall be making the following amendments which will take effect from 25 May 2018:

- New definition 'Data Protection Legislation' (i) The Data Protection Act 2018 (ii) The General Data Protection Regulation ((EU) 2016/679) and any national implementing laws, regulations and secondary legislation, as amended or updated from time to time, in the UK (iii) any other laws and regulations relating to the processing of personal data and privacy which apply to a party and, if applicable, the guidance and codes of practice issued by the relevant data protection or supervisory authority.
- All references to the 'Data Protection Act 1998' will be replaced by 'Data Protection Legislation'.
- All references to 'personal data' will be replaced by 'personal data and special category data'.
